

Assumed dead load =120 Total unit load, w, --370 Area of slab is 17 X 17--289 square feet and area of circular plate 5.3 X 3.14 = 88 square feet; hence the difference of the two areas is 201 square feet, which is the area of slab outside of the assumed circular plate. The loading of this area is supported along the circumference of the flat plate, and equals 201 X 370 = 74 370 pounds.
