In 1963, Zulfikar Ghose received a special award from the E. C. Gregory Trust that was judged by T. S. Eliot, Henry Moore, Herbert Read and Bonamy Dobree. By the time he was featured in The Review of Contemporary Fiction, Ghose had been accorded major status as a writer of international repute: the editors of The Review of Contemporary Fiction noted that Zulfikar Ghose has both ranked with and outranked several of the best English language writers in England and America, and went on to present him as a unique figure in contemporary literature, whose evolution across languages and national boundaries was comparable to Conrad, Nabokov and Beckett.
